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Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to introduce Go 4 Schools, an online tool that allows parents, carers and pupils to access all their key information. This is in response to parental feedback and requests for improved communication and transparency in what we do.

Using Go 4 Schools, you will be able to view your child's progress online and access the following information at any time:

- **Real-time attainment information** – marks and target grades for all subjects throughout the year.
- **Homework** – homework tasks due in the next 7 days.
- **Attendance** – shown from the start of the academic year.
- **Timetable** – your child's daily and weekly timetable.
- **Behaviour information** – all behaviour incidents are recorded, both negative and positive.

Your child's page is constantly updated, providing you with the latest information. A weekly email notification is also sent that provides parents with a weekly summary.


To access the site, please go to www.go4schools.com and click on the 'Parents' icon at the top of the main page to arrive at the log-in screen. The email address you use to enter the site must be the one we have registered in our database for you.

If you would like to provide us with a new or different email address, please email Rachel Gale on dataexams@noelbakeracademy.co.uk with the necessary details. Rachel will also be able to assist you if you encounter any problems.

To request a password for Go 4 Schools, please enter your email address into the First-Time User field and click 'Please send me a password'. A randomised password will then be generated and sent to your email address. You will then be able to log into the site and view your child's page.


